Resources for Breast cancer

Patient and family can have access various local resources, programs and financial aid to for help through a breast cancer diagnosis and treatment. Here are some of the available programs in our community for breast cancer. Financial Support ORION Cancer Foundation: assistance with mortgage or rent payments, utilities, groceries, health insurance premium or COBRA premiums. Patient Advocate Foundation Co-Pay Relief Program: prescription assistance for those with health insurance/Medicare/Medicaid. Partnership for Prescription Assistance: prescription assistance for uninsured/underinsure.

Rose Support Services: assistance with rent, utilities, groceries, and transportation costs during treatment Emotional Support Barbara Greenspun WomensCare Center: breast cancer support groups and healing yoga. The Caring Place: wellness seminars, healing arts, yoga, reiki, reflexology, healing touch, massage therapy, support groups Center for Compassionate Care: breast cancer counseling for survivors & their families, various support groups Treatment Support Access to Healthcare Network: screening and diagnostic services for uninsured over the age of 50. Program: screening and diagnostic services for uninsured women with breast cancer under the age of 50. Mammovan: mobile mammography screening services for uninsured women. Planned Parenthood: clinical breast examinations for uninsured women.
